I consider it a great honour to present before you the Annual Report of our college for the year 2017-18.

**PROFILE OF THE COLLEGE**

The Anbanathapuram Vahaira Charities, an organization with a track record of more than two centuries was established in 1806 by the philanthropic members of the five families of Anbanathapuram, Enathimangalam, Pallavarayapet, Karukudi and Kanganamputhur. In 1955, the A.V. Charities established the A.V.C. College to serve the cause of higher education. The institution was started with 120 students in intermediate class, which has now grown and into a Post-Graduate and Research institution with a current strength of 5158 students which includes 3001 women students, 165 M.Phil. and 135 Ph.D. Scholars. Our college offers 24 Under-Graduate, 19 Post-Graduate degree programmes, 8 M.Phil., and 9 Ph.D., research programmes and 3 PG Diploma Programmes.

Now 264 teaching and 102 non-teaching staff are serving in the College. Autonomous status was conferred on us in 1987 and since then the college has taken innovative steps and measures in the areas of teaching, learning, evaluation, research and extension activities. We have been awarded 'A' Grade by NAAC who assessed us for the third time. I am very proud to state here that our College has been awarded the status of "College with Potential for Excellence" (Phase-II), a very rare honour offered by UGC. In recent NIRF Ranking, our college is placed Rank Band 101-150 by Ministry of Human Resource Development, Government of India.

### **STAFF APPOINTMENT / RETIREMENT:**

Totally, 20 teaching and 5 non-teaching staff have been appointed in the Evening Section and 06 teaching staff and 11 non-teaching staff in the Aided section during this academic year 2017-18. Mr. C. Panneerselvam, HOD of Physics and Dr. K. Senthilnayagam, Librarian, are retiring this year after long meritorious service. Mrs. A. Josepheen, Superintendent and Mrs. A. Vanjulavalli, Steno-Typist (Special Grade) have retired this year after long meritorious service. We place on record our sincere thanks and appreciation for the selfless service rendered by these members of the staff to our institution.
