PROFILE OF THE COLLEGE

The Anbanathapuram Vahaira Charities, an organization with a track record of more than two centuries was established in 1806 by the philanthropic members of the five families of Anbanathapuram, Enathimangalam, Pallavarayapet, Karukudi and Kanganamputhur. In 1955, the A.V. Charities established the A.V.C. College to serve the cause of higher education. The institution was started with 120 students in intermediate class, which has now grown into a Post-Graduate and Research institution with a current strength of 4453 students which includes 2550 women students, 59 M.Phil. and 139 Ph.D. Scholars. Our college offers 24 Under-Graduate, 19 Post-Graduate degree programmes, 8 M.Phil., and 9 Ph.D., research programmes and 3 PG Diploma Programmes.

Now 241 teaching and 91 non-teaching staff are serving in the College. Autonomous status was conferred on us 1987 and since then the college has taken innovative steps and measures in the areas of teaching, learning, evaluation, research and extension activities.
