PROFILE OF THE COLLEGE

The Anbanathapuram Vahaira Charities, an organization with a track record of more than two centuries was established in 1806 by the philanthropic members of the five families of Anbanathapuram, Enathimangalam, Pallavarayapet, Karukudi and Kanganamputhur. In 1955, the A.V. Charities established the A.V.C. College to serve the cause of higher education. The institution was established with 120 students in intermediate class, which has now grown into a Post-Graduate and Research institution with a current strength of 4454 students which includes 2532 women students, 9 M.Phil. and 73 Ph.D. Scholars. Our college offers 23 Under-Graduate, 17 Post-Graduate degree programmes, 8 M.Phil., and 9 Ph.D., research programmes.

Now 258 teaching and 115 non-teaching staff are serving in the College. Autonomous status was conferred on us 1987 and since then the college has taken innovative steps and measures in the areas of teaching, learning, evaluation, research and extension activities. I am happy to record that our college has been awarded 'A+' Grade by NAAC with CGPA of 3.46/4.00 in 4th Cycle in the recent peer team visit. I am very proud to state here that our College has been awarded the status of "College with Potential for Excellence" (Phase-II), a very rare honour offered by UGC. Our College has been placed in the Rank Band 101-150 by NIRF Ranking in 2022 by the Ministry of Human Resource Development, Government of India and the same position is retained for the last five years. I am happy to inform you that our college was awarded a Best Arts and Science College in the Delta Region by NEWS 18 Channel through "Katral Award 2022". Further, our College received "Best NSS Unit Award" by the Bharathidasan University on 27th March 2023 for the year 2019-20.

A Digital Library with one IBM Server, 16 CCTV cameras and barcode scanners are available in the Library. 160 books were added recently at the Cost around Rs. 1,35,000/-.

HOSTEL

Our college Hostel provides accommodation for both men and women separately. Also college is generous enough in providing free boarding and lodging for differently abled students, outstanding sports persons in our Men's Hostel.

HIGHER EDUCATION FOR PERSONS WITH SPECIAL NEEDS (HEPSN)

Our college provides free boarding and lodging and exempts the payment of examination fee for students with special needs.

HEPSN has rendered a yeomen service to the disabled students our college. There are 18 differently abled students studying in our college both in UG and PG levels. Among the 18 students 12 of them are visually impaired. Our college's philanthropic College is very magnanimous enough to provide free boarding and lodging and exemption of payment of college tuition fee. The organization has arranged scribe assistance during the test and examinations days. Our college finance committee has granted rupees 200 per session towards the scribe remuneration. Students have applied

for Tamil Nadu Social Welfare Scholarship and National Scholarship for Persons with Disabilities. Among the 12 visually impaired students 8 of them have been selected for receiving the tablet from the Social welfare department. A special software called Talk Back is installed in these tablets. It helped the user to listen and identify the icon through voice recognition. Tamil Nadu Government Social Welfare department has issued Smart National ID card to all the differently abled students.

SCHOLARSHIPS & GRANTS

During 2022-23, a sum of Rs. 10,69,110/- was received on different heads as scholarships, benefiting 423 students of the Day College and Rs.22,62,247/- benefiting 797 students of the Evening Section which were distributed directly through students' bank accounts.

A sum of Rs. 1,00,275/- was received as Private scholarship for 13 students from various organizations/Trust/well-wishers., etc.

A total of Rs. 6,00,000/- was rempursed from UGC as Autonomous Grant for the Year 2018-19 & 2019- 2020.
