### **PROFILE OF THE COLLEGE**

The Anbanathapuram Vahaira Charities, an organization with a track record of more than two centuries was established in 1806 by the philanthropic members of the five families of Anbanathapuram, Enathimangalam, Pallavarayapet, Karukudi and Kanganamputhur. In 1955, the A.V. Charities established the A.V.C. College to serve the cause of higher education. Now the College is administrated by the Judge Administrator, Honourable Justice Mr. K. Venkataraman. The institution was established with 120 students in intermediate class, which has now grown into a Post-Graduate and Research institution with a current strength of 4488 students which includes 2555 women students, and 81 Ph.D. Scholars. Our college offers 23 Under-Graduate, 17 Post-Graduate degree programmes, 8 M.Phil., and 9 Ph.D., research programmes.

Now 256 teaching and 111 non-teaching staff are serving in the College. Autonomous status was conferred on us 1987 and since then the college has taken innovative steps and measures in the areas of teaching, learning, evaluation, research and extension activities. I am happy to record that our college has been awarded 'A+' Grade by NAAC with CGPA of 3.46/4.00 in 4th Cycle in the recent peer team visit. I am very proud to state here that our College has been awarded the status of "College with Potential for Excellence" (Phase-II), a very rare honour offered by UGC. Our College has been placed in the Rank Band 101-150 by NIRF Ranking in 2023 by the Ministry of Human Resource Development, Government of India and the same position is retained for the last six years.

#### HOSTEL

Our college Hostel provides accommodation for both men and women separately. Also Administrator is generous in providing free boarding and lodging for differently abled students, outstanding sports persons in our Men's Hostel.

#### HIGHER EDUCATION FOR PERSONS WITH SPECIAL NEEDS (HEPSN)

Our college and Administrator provide free boarding and lodging and exempts the payment of examination fee for students with special needs.

HEPSN has rendered a yeomen service to the disabled students of our college. There are 38 differentlyabled students studying in our college both in UG and PG levels. Among the 38 students 12 of them are visually impaired. Our college philanthropic managementis very magnanimous enough toprovide free boardingand lodging and exempted the payment ofcollege tution fee. The organization has arranged scribe assistance during the test and examinations days. Our college finance committee has grantedrupees 200 per session towards the scribe remuneration. They have applied for Tamil Nadu Social Welfare Scholarship and National Scholarship for Persons with Disabilty. They have received a sum of Rs.1,60,000 [One Lakh and Sixty Thousand]. They have received Android mobile phone. A special software called Talk Back is installed in these mobile phones. It helped the user to listen and identify the icon through voice recognition. Tamil Nadu Government Social Welfare department has issued Smart National ID card to all the differently abled students.

### **SCHOLARSHIPS & GRANTS**

During 2023-24, 1782 students applied for the scholarship in different heads which were distributed directly through students' bank accounts.

A sum of Rs. 1,33,210/- was received as Private scholarship for 13 students from various organizations/Trust/well-wishers., etc.

A total of Rs. 26,85,607/- was reimbursed from UGC as CPE – Phase – II grant.
