
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
- Joint teaching programs, research activities, publications and explore the possibilities of joint academic programs in inter-disciplinary areas of specialization of high relevance to both institutions in the field of **History**
- Participation in seminars and academic meetings.

Each party recognizes that the other party has, may have, or will have arrangements of a similar or different nature with other institutions whether in each party's areas of activity, during the tenure of this MoU.

This MoU is for the purpose of advancement of Knowledge and it is not for any commercial interest. For using the institution's name (ADM College or AVC College) in any activity clear communication and discussion need to be undertaken, beforehand. During the organization of events, seminars and other events the preparation of seminar proposals*, invitations and other arrangements shall be undertaken in a transparent manner through proper discussions with both the parties.


Arbitration

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MoU)

This MoU is made and entered into on the 16th day of February, 2017 (Hereinafter referred to as "Effective Date") at Chennai by and

BETWEEN

National Biodiversity Authority, an autonomous and statutory body, established under Section 8 of The Biological Diversity Act, 2002, Government of India (Hereinafter referred to as "NBA") having its head office situated at 5th Floor, TICEL Biopark, Taramani, Chennai - 600 113, India and acting through its Chairman.

AND

A.V.C. College (Autonomous), Mannampandal, Mayiladuthurai - 609 305, Nagapattinam District, Tamil nadu State established and existing under the laws of India and having its registered/corporate office/Head Office (or one of its offices) at A.V.C. College (Autonomous), Mannampandal, Mayiladuthurai - 609 305 (Hereinafter referred to as "A.V.C. College (Autonomous)" and includes the legal heirs, assigns, successors and administrators)

Hereinafter, NBA and "Anbanathapuram Vahaira Charities College" shall individually be referred to as "Party" and collectively as "Parties".

WHEREAS:

The Parties have on the basis of their respective mandates, a common aim in furtherance of conservation of biological diversity and its sustainable use;

NBA has been entrusted by the Government of India with certain resources that can be allocated for programs and projects, and is accountable to the Ministry of Environment and Forests, Government of India for the proper management of these funds and can, in accordance with the NBA's Regulations and Rules made under the Biological Diversity Act, 2002 ('Act'), make available such resources for cooperation in the form of one time support (disbursed in staggered manner);

The **A.V.C. College (Autonomous), Mannampandal, Mayiladuthurai**, its status being in accordance with national regulations, is committed to the principles of participatory conservation of biological diversity and its sustainable use, has demonstrated the capacity needed for the activity/activities involved, in accordance with the NBA requirements for management; is apolitical and not profit-making;

NBA and **A.V.C. College (Autonomous)** have entered into this MoU for the purpose of attaining the following:

Project Proposal entitled "International Conference on "Current Challenges in Conservation of Biodiversity (In4CB-2017).

AND the parties hereby agree that the activities proposed shall be undertaken without discrimination, direct or indirect, of race, ethnicity, religion, creed, gender, handicapped status, or any other circumstances and that the goals of gender equity and community participation are incorporated in the implementation of project activities.

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of mutual covenants set forth herein, and for other good and valuable consideration, the Parties hereby agree as follows:-

Article I. Definitions

Throughout this MoU, the reference to any word shall mean as defined in Article 1 as detailed hereunder.

(a) "Project Coordinator/Coordinator/Nominated Representative/Representative" shall mean the one who acts as the overall coordinator for the Project and assumes the primary responsibility for all aspects of the project;

(b) "Expenditure" shall mean the sum of disbursements made and valid outstanding obligations incurred in respect of goods and services rendered;

(c) "Project Work Plan/Event/Program" shall mean a schedule of activities, with corresponding time frames and responsibilities that are based upon the Project Document deemed necessary to achieve project results, prepared at the time of approval of the project. Project Works shall incorporate the Event/Project Activities/Outputs/Objectives and Budget.

Article II. Acknowledgement of support provided and related matters

NBA and the Ministry of Environment and Forests & Climate Change (MoEF&CC) will be acknowledged in all the activities undertaken through this MoU, including in all publications and related materials. NBA and MoEF&CC reserve the right on full copyright provisions of the material, provision of Authorship and the related matters. The **A.V.C. College (Autonomous)** agrees not to claim any rights or privileges on the above issues.

Article III. Duration of MoU

The term of the present MoU shall commence from16-2-2017 (date, month and year) and terminate on ...15-8-2017 (date, month and year). The Project Work Plan/Event shall commence and be completed in accordance with the time frame described. Any change in the time/schedule is to be intimated well in advance to NBA. If required, the duration may be extended by the Chairman, NBA.

Article IV. Roles and Responsibilities

1. **A.V.C. College (Autonomous)** shall provide any other details required about the Program Work Plan/Project/Event to NBA prior to and after the signing of the MoU.
2. **A.V.C. College (Autonomous)** agrees to carry out his/its responsibilities in accordance with the provisions of the present MoU, and to undertake the Project in accordance with NBA policies and procedures, ensuring that the image of NBA is not hampered in any manner. The Parties also agree that the work under the Event / Program shall be carried out in an efficient manner as possible.
3. **A.V.C. The selection of required manpower will be at its sole discretion and also to ensure the successful and timely completion of the project. Both parties shall determine and communicate to the other Party (or unit) having the ultimate authority and responsibility for the Event / Program on its behalf, who will be responsible for day-to-day contacts with each other on operational matters during the implementation of the Event/Project. This includes ensuring proper utilization and disbursement of funds. The Parties intend that, to the maximum extent possible and unless otherwise approved by the other Party, all significant communications between the Parties shall be made through the authorized representatives.
4. **A.V.C. College (Autonomous)** shall be fully responsible for all services performed by its personnel, agents, employees, or contractors (Hereinafter referred to as "Personnel"). Such personnel shall not be considered in any respect as being the employees or agents of NBA. The **A.V.C. College (Autonomous)** shall ensure that its personnel meet the highest standard of qualification and technical and professional competence necessary for the achievement of the Objectives of the Event / Project. They shall refrain from any conduct that would adversely reflect on NBA and shall not engage in any activity which is incompatible with the aims and objectives of the mandate of NBA. The **A.V.C. College (Autonomous)** shall be responsible for, and deal with all claims brought against it by its Personnel.

5. The **A.V.C. College (Autonomous)** through its authorized representative shall keep NBA informed and updated on all activities pertaining to the Event/ project.

6. **A.V.C. College (Autonomous)** shall be solely responsible for obtaining any licenses and permits required by national laws, wherever appropriate and necessary for the achievement of the Objectives of the Project.

7. NBA does not accept any liability for claims arising out of the activities performed under the present MoU, or any claims for breach of copyrights, events of plagiarism, death, bodily injury, disability, damage to property or other hazards that may be suffered by the **A.V.C. College (Autonomous)**'s personnel as a result of their work pertaining to the project.

8. The MoU will be signed only on receipt of and acceptance by NBA of the detailed Program / Event. In accordance with the Project Budget, NBA will make available to the **A.V.C. College (Autonomous)**, funds up to the maximum amount mentioned in **Annexure A** and release of the funds would commence only after signing of present MoU. The first installment of 75% of the funds will be advanced to **A.V.C. College (Autonomous)** within seven working days from the Effective Date of the present MoU. The second and final installment of 25% would be released on receipt of the detailed technical and audited financial report including Utilization Certificate for the activities completed and submitted to and accepted by NBA as showing satisfactory management and use of NBA resources.

9. The final version of **"International Conference on Current Challenges in Conservation of Biodiversity (In4cB-2017)"** developed under this project will become the property of NBA.

10. The **A.V.C. College (Autonomous)** agrees to utilize the funds and any supplies provided by NBA in strict accordance with the NBA guiding principles. The parties shall use the funds provided under the project exclusively for the project work. On proposal on the **"International Conference on Current Challenges in Conservation of Biodiversity (In4cB-2017)"** the **A.V.C. 2. The Parties understand that their participation in this MoU does not constitute an endorsement, express or implied of any policy advocated by them.
3. The **A.V.C. College (Autonomous)** shall be solely responsible for the effective management of fund and implementation of the program in accordance with the program guidelines and with ethical and legal standards.
4. The Parties agree to work in coordinated manner and cooperate with each other for the successful implementation of the project.
5. The formal sanction order issued by NBA for release of funds will form part of this MoU.
6. The entire activity/all activities/project etc. shall be completed as per time frame.

Article VII. TERMINATION OF MoU

This MoU shall be valid for a period of Six months (in words) months from the Effective Date up to 15-8-2017 (date, month and year) unless formally extended or terminated due to non-compliance of any of the Clauses of this MoU or due to inefficient implementation of the program component(s). The reasons to terminate the project may include any one or more of the following reasons:

1. The money released have not been utilized as per the approved budget and work plan
2. Progress in implementation of the agreed Event / Project Work Plan (qualitatively and quantitatively) is poor
3. There is reasonable evidence of fraud and dishonesty
4. The standard / quality of work is below expected level

In case of any dispute regarding Clauses (1) to (4) stated above, the decision of the NBA is final.

If the Project is terminated for any reason all unspent money from the advance released to the Project as well as any interest accrued shall be returned to NBA within thirty days from the date of termination.

Article VIII. Survival

The obligations of the Parties under this MoU are of binding nature and shall survive the termination or expiration of the MoU.

Article IX. Privileges and Immunities
